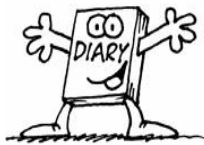
- Friday 5th July: "Around the World in 80 pictures". We know our Cashmere church family are a well-travelled lot, so why not share some of those experiences with
